**Declarations made outside of New Zealand** as defined in Section 11 of the Oaths and Declarations Act 1957

- Justice of Peace
- Judge
- Notary Public
- Commissioner of Oaths
- Or other person authorised by the law of that country to administer an oath under Section 11 of the Oaths and Declarations Act 1957
